This week is a huge week for our football club, and we hope to make the players of the past 100 years proud.

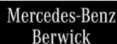
Reserves

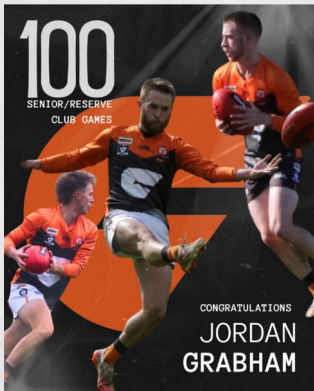
